The $100^{\text {th }}$ day of school will be Friday, January 16, 2015. This is a wonderful opportunity to explore many math skills. Our class will be celebrating in TRUE 100 Day fashion. It will be a day filled with many fun and exciting math activities. Please note some critical second grade math skills:
**Counting and grouping in patterns: by 2's, 5's, \& 10's to 100
**Recognizing odd and even numbers (including double-digit and triple digit \#'s)
**Place value (ones, tens, and hundreds place)
**Counting money up to \& back 100 cents /100 dollars And much, much more..............


Language Arts
Children will be working on folktales, fables, and fairy tales. Students will explore the various features of this genre. Reader's Theater will also be incorporated into this unit. Opinion writing will be highlighted during Writer's Workshop. Students will be utilizing various graphic organizers in order to best develop and organize their thoughts and ideas.

Math
Students are now focusing on Measurement and Time. Students will be utilizing different units of measurement (inches, centimeters, feet, \& yards) to measure various items. Students must be able to make reasonable estimations of length as well as determine the appropriate tool and unit needed to measure a given object. Standard vs. nonstandard units of measurement will be reviewed. Second graders must also be able to tell time to the nearest five minutes and identify relationships of time such as the number of minutes in an hour and hours in a day. Social Studies/Science
Students will learn about the life and accomplishments of Martin Luther King. We will create our very own timeline to display in the hallway. As February nears, students will discuss the various accomplishments of other exceptional African-Americans in honor of Black History Month. Astronomy is our next unit of study in science. What fun!
