### Language Arts

Your child has been focusing on sentence components (nouns, verbs, adjectives, etc.). Words in a sentence must go in a certain order and <u>must</u> begin with a capital letter and end with a certain punctuation mark. Root words, suffixes, antonyms, synonyms, and homophones will be future skills discussed. Dictionary skills are yet another focal point. Students are learning to utilize guide words in order to locate the word in the book.

#### Math

Fact families will be reviewed. We want children to notice the patterns in numbers. Subtraction and addition work together! If 3+4=7 and 4+3=7, then 7-3=4 and 7-4=3. We have been discussing the math terms of equivalent and nonequivalent and will continue our representations of numbers in a variety of ways (i.e. 53 can be represented as 50+3, 56-3, 5 tens and 3 ones, etc.). Basic properties of addition (commutative & associative) will be utilized to simplify problems.

#### Social Studies/Science

Life Cycles will continue to be our science unit. Students will study the parts of plants and research the life cycles of various animals. Christopher Columbus's journey to America will also be discussed in honor of Columbus Day. Thanks again for all you do to support at-home learning!
