

Language Arts

Children have been working on features of non-fiction texts. Comparing and contrasting fiction vs. non-fiction as well as the various components (table of contents, glossary, index, diagrams, captions, etc.) has been a major focus. Informational writing continues to be our writing genre

. Math

Fact families will be reviewed. We want children to notice the patterns in numbers. Subtraction and addition work together! If 3+4=7 and 4+3=7, then 7-3=4 and 7-4=3. We have been discussing the math terms of equivalent and nonequivalent and will continue our representations of numbers in a variety of ways (i.e. 53 can be represented as 50+3, 56-3, 5 tens and 3 ones, etc.). Basic properties of addition (commutative & associative) will be utilized to simplify problems.

Social Studies/Science

Thanksgiving has been explored over the past week. The students have learned about various aspects of the Pilgrim's journey, its harsh conditions, and the determination it takes to really make a difference. Students will be exploring historical figures (Mary Musgrove, Tomochichi, & James Oglethorpe). Native Americans indigenous to Georgia (the Creek and Cherokee) will be discussed in the weeks to come.
