## DESK OF MR Athon

### Language Arts

Our class has focused on nonfiction book features over the past 2 weeks. Students have studied the purpose of the table of contents, index, glossary, headings, captions, diagrams, etc. It is important for students to use these elements to better understand the content of the book. Commas in a series as well as commas in a date have also been discussed. In addition, students have read passages and studied context clues in order to answer various comprehension questions. All of these skills are essential for strong second grade readers and writers!

#### Math

Fact families have been reviewed. We want children to notice the patterns in numbers. Subtraction and addition work together! If 3+4=7 and 4+3=7, then 7-3=4 and 7-4=3. We have been discussing the math terms of equivalent and nonequivalent. Basic properties of addition (commutative & associative) will be utilized to simplify problems as well a variety of strategies to solve one & twodigit addition and subtraction problems.

#### Social Studies/Science

States of Matter has been our primary focus in science. Students have studied the various properties of matter as well as their chemical and physical changes. New vocabulary words have been introduced (i.e. mass, volume, properties, etc.) Our Native American (Creek & Cherokee) unit has concluded. Next up: Civil Rights in Social Studies & Astronomy in Science!
