## CogAT Testing

Second graders will be taking the CogAT on Mon. 9/15, Tues. 9/16, and Wed. 9/17. This is a test of a student's cognitive abilities and measures scholastic aptitude. Therefore, there is nothing to do to prepare for the test. Of course we stress the importance of doing their best, but there is NO need for worry and concern. I know they will all do a fabulous job!

# Language Arts

Your child will be working on the four different types of sentences: declarative, interrogative, exclamatory, & imperative. We will also discuss an author's purpose in writing (i.e. to entertain, persuade, or inform) and the various parts of a book. Students need to know where to locate the title, author, illustrator, publisher, and the publication date of various works. Reader's Workshop is moving right along. Be sure to ask your child about responding to their reading. I know you will be impressed!



Place value continues to be our math focus. Students are learning to represent, count, read, & write numbers to 1000 as well as compare two and three digit numbers. Skip counting by 5's, 10's, and 100's up to 1000 will also be an area of focus. Second graders will use a variety of models, diagrams, and base ten numerals in order to best express numbers to 1000.

### Social Studies/Science

We have wrapped up our study of maps and their parts. Regions of Georgia as well as landforms located throughout Georgia will be our next area of focus in Social Studies. Life Cycles will be our first Science unit. Students will study the parts of plants and research the life cycles of various animals. We will be visiting the Science Lab over the next few weeks to do our first BIG experiment. Yippee!

#### Accelerated Reader

Ms. Athon's students love this program and it truly shows. Our class earned 2<sup>nd</sup> place for the most points in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. AR tests are available on most of our media center books and are strongly encouraged. Our goal is 30 plus points for 100% of Ms Athon's second graders this year. Let's encourage our students to earn those AR points and enhance their reading skills, too. Thanks!
